

St Nicholas' Fortress

- unique construction of the Venetian Renaissance fortification architecture, represents a monument of world heritage in the Mediterranean
- it was built in the 16th century on the islet of Ljuljevac at the site of the former Benedictine Monastery of St Nicholas, from which it took its name






In 2017 St Nicholas' Fortress was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List

• part of a transnational nomination entitled:

Venetian Works of Defence between the 16th and 17th Centuries: Stato da Terra – Western Stato da Mar, which also includes the Defensive System of Zadar, Fortified City of Bergamo, Fortified City of Peschiera del Garda, City Fortress of Palmanova in Italy, and Fortified City of Kotor in Montenegro

CRITERION (III): The Venetian Works of Defence provide an exceptional testimony of the *alla moderna* **military culture**, which evolved within the Republic of Venice in the 16th and 17th centuries, involving vast territories and interactions from Venetian *terraferma* to the Levant

CRITERION (IV): The Venetian Works of Defence present the characteristics of the alla moderna **fortified system** (bastioned system) built by the Republic of Venice following changes that were introduced following the increased use of firearms





The Venetian Works of Defence between 16th and 17th centuries: Stato datesta - Vestera Stato da Mar LA FOSSA

- The construction of St Nicholas' Fortress started at the very end of the so called third Ottoman Venetian war, around 1540 as the response of Republic of Venice to the powerful Turkish naval force
- The construction began according to plans by Giangirolamo Sanmicheli, the nephew of famous Venetian architect Michele Sanmicheli and under his supervision
- The basic layout form of the fort is a **triangle**, with a round shaped bastion **rondel** directed towards the channel, and **two demi-bastions towards the land**, on the south side, which create a *tenaglia*, an element that appeared here very early in Venetian military architecture







ENTRANCE - RENAISSANCE

- two internal floors
- a spacious terrace
- system of skylights
- combination of construction materials
- decorative elements











...for a long time the fortress was under military administration, therefore isolated from the local population...

but today it is on its way to **revitalization**!




SIGNIFICANT LANDSCAPE CHANNEL PORT




The area chosen as **buffer zone** has been selected within the Channel – Port in Šibenik' area, categorized as "Protected Areas-Category V" in the IUCN classification, characterized by a "Significant Importance". Furthermore, this area is part of the **European ecological network NATURA 2000 Krka estuary**

Management of the St Nicholas' Fortress

St Nicholas' Fortress is world-famous for its impressive fortification architecture and for being located in a unique natural environment, where natural and cultural heritage are closely intertwined. The common objective of its protection and use is to maintain its **authenticity**, to manage it according to the principles of **sustainability**, thereby benefiting local residents, visitors and future generations

Local Management Plan for St Nicholas' Fortress

 designed by the Institute for Tourism, Zagreb in collaboration with experts at the Croatian Conservation Institute in 2019 and presented to the public

Management principles:

- Protection
- Sustainable use
- Participative management

The Local Management Plan for St Nicholas' Fortress is developed within the project:

- Tourism Valorization of St Nicholas' Fortress in the St Anthony's Channel
- Co-financed with EU Structural Funds
- covers a 10 year period

The other **significant documents** derivated from the same project are:


- Designed studies and surveys for architectural projects
- Developed architectural (conceptual, master and execution) designs for St Nicholas' Fortress
- Developed architectural (conceptual, master and execution) designs for access infrastructure
- Prepared documentation for **environment and nature protection**
- Prepared documentation for the **application** of the integrated programme implementation related to the EU structural funds





Financed from the same project in 2020. *The Tourist Carrying Capacity* for the Significant Landscape Channel-Port was made as part of the *Action Plan for the Management of Visitors to the Significant Landscape*.

The part of Significant Landscape is also a *buffer zone* of the St Nicholas' Fortress.





Public institution Nature is implementing Local Management Plan for St Nicholas' Fortress continuously through activities of **protection**, **valorization**, **restoration and maintenance of the building architecture** and **sustainable use** - activities of **sustainable tourism**, **promotion**, **interpretation**, **education and cooperation**











FORTRESS PROTECTION – STATE OF CONSERVATION

~ Rehabilitation and reconstruction of the fortress ~

- complete project documentation for the reconstruction and rehabilitation of the fortress (prepared by the Croatian Restoration Institute) including the project application for the second phase which would finance the complete renovation of the building
- after obtaining a building permit and confirmation of the main renovation project from all administrative bodies, conservators and the Ministry of Culture and Media of the Republic of Croatia, the Public Institution Nature is waiting the opening of an adequate call for EU funds for implementation the second phase of the project - financing complete building restoration





In the meantime, rehabilitation and restoration works are being carried out in phases, given the availability of funds:

- all the works are being carried out according to the Conservation and Technical Study of the Restoration of the St Nicholas' Fortress and renovation project documentation made by the Croatian Restoration Institute without compromising the Outstanding Universal Value of the monument
- the funds are provided by the Croatian Ministry of Culture and Media






ILLUSTRATION OF THE LATERAL SURFACE OF THE FORTRESS BY TYPES OF MATERIALS – top view of the fortress plateau






ILLUSTRATION OF THE LATERAL SURFACE WITH DATING OF THE MATERIAL USED - top view of the fortress plateau

USE OF THE FORTRESS

Organized visiting of the Fortress – Sea transport system

Since mid-June 2019 St Nicholas' Fortress opened its doors to visitors...

- for the time being, due to demanding restoration and conservation works, it is possible to visit St Nicholas' Fortress by boat, organized by the Public Institution Nature of the Šibenik-Knin County
- boat trip includes boat transport, admission to the monument site, guided tour during the visit to the fortress, with the use of multimedia guides (tablet-based AR technology)

Of the existing visitor infrastructure outside significant landscape Channel – Port St Nicholas' Fortress Information Centre / The Ticket Office is opened since 2019

- located in the city of Šibenik, on the Šibenik waterfront, near the location from where the organized boat tour starts to the Fortress
- managed by Public Institution Nature





INFRASTRUCTURE – buffer zone

Tourism Valorization of the St Anthony's Channel in Šibenik – phase 1



- the St Anthony's Channel is part of the significant landscape Channel Port in Šibenik. It spreads from the Šibenik Bridge to the end of the channel, to St Nicholas' Fortress
- the project included a promenade along the south-east shore of the channel, from Panikovac Cove in Šibenik Bay to St Nicholas' Fortress at the entrance to the channel

The overall objective of the project was to contribute growth in the tourism sector of the Šibenik-Knin County, to improve public tourism infrastructure and management system in order to plan the development as well as to promote selective aspects of active and cultural tourism and related services in the natural protected areas and Natura 2000 sites within the Šibenik-Knin County

Tourism Valorization of the St Anthony's Channel – phase 2

Visitor Center - added content in the buffer zone

Through the project "Tourism valorization of the St'Anthony's Channel Šibenik - phase 2" worth 3.540.633,72 € co-financed by the European Union from the European Regional Development Fund:

- unique visitor center with the permanent exhibition setup dedicated to protected natural and cultural heritage of the Šibenik-Knin County
- a coffee bar with an open terrace and a winter garden
- an educational trail for the visually impaired and blind from Škar Bay to the visitor center

- sanitary facilities

The project holder is Public Institution Nature of Šibenik-Knin County, and the partners are Šibenik-Knin County, Tourist bord of the Šibenik-Knin County, and the Public Institution Development Agency of Šibenik-Knin County.









- guided tours and workshops for children - preschool and school pupils



- The modern multimedia hall is equipped with an audio-visual projection system for projections, lectures and educational workshops.










